#### Crotched Mountain Slope Days Program (formerly Voyager Program) details

#### Program:

- 6 weeks of lessons
- 2 products: Lift/Lesson/Rental (\$319) **OR** Epic Pass holder package is 6 lessons (\$160)
- students must be age 7-18, unless approved by Crotched Mountain

#### **Schedule:**

- Fridays
- Lesson start time: 5 pm

- Starting week Friday 1/12/23
- Ending week Friday 2/16/23
- Make up lessons have not yet been decided upon so be sure you make it to as many lessons as possible

#### How to Sign Up

The only way you can sign up and get the discounted rate is to call the Crotched Mountain Ticket Office's direct line at 603-842-7534. When signing up be sure to give them our unique group code of STJ, and just to be sure tell them you are with St. Joseph Regional School which includes Our Lady of Mercy Academy and that you want Friday lessons at 5pm. Since the negations with Vail to continue offering the ski school program for schools that have been loyal to Crotched Mountain were completed after the website was developed for the season, the prices on the website are higher than if you were to call the ticket office. There are only a handful of local SAUs and our school that have been offered this special discounted rate.

If you know of anyone in your group of family or friends that would like to take advantage of this discounted rate, please forward this email to them and have sign up under our school group code of STJ to receive the discounted rate.

Please sign up as soon as possible, as one part of their website has a sign up date of **Sunday**, **December 10**, **2023** and another part has a sign up date of **Friday**, **December 15<sup>th</sup> so sooner than later is always better**. While in the past they have been very flexible in their sign up page, I'm not sure how this year will work.

There are additional changes on how rentals forms and weekly lift tickets will be handled so stay tuned for these updates. They did away with chaperone passes but added some other passes so stay tuned for details on that process and I will pass along the information as I receive it. Bottom line is, the more participates with have, the more passes we may receive.
