

Father Greg's visit to Keene involved conversations with faith communities, city officials, area residents and local youth, where he imparted the idea of a "circle of compassion" with "nobody standing outside that circle." The Mercy students were all required to read Father Greg's book, *Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion*, for their summer reading going into the 2022-2023 school year. It was an extraordinary opportunity for the students to hear from Father Greg directly and spend a bit of time with Wilber and Sergio (shown with the students above).




