Parish Tuition Assistance for Families of St. Joseph Regional School and

Our Lady of Mercy Academy

2025-2026 School Year

Dear Parents and Guardians,

To assist parents who desire a Catholic education for their grade school children at St. Joseph Regional School and/or Our Lady of Mercy Academy in Keene, the Parish of the Holy Spirit has established a Tuition Assistance Program. This program is intended for families who are active, registered, and weekly Mass-attending parishioners of the Parish of the Holy Spirit. Our tuition assistance program is a needs-based assistance program and not a merit-based scholarship fund. This tuition assistance is possible because of the generosity of the parishioners of the Parish of the Holy Spirit and is funded by the parish's general offertory and various other fundraising initiatives such as the parish's Love for Life campaign and fundraising dinners. The pastor of the Parish of the Holy Spirit, as steward of the parish resources, is committed to helping those parishioners, with children in our Catholic schools, in need of tuition assistance as resources allow. Eligibility for the parish tuition assistance program is limited to active, registered, weekly Mass-attending parishioners of the Parish of the Holy Spirit.

Each year the pastor, with the assistance of the parish finance council, determines a fixed amount set aside exclusively for tuition assistance at St. Joseph Regional School and Our Lady of Mercy Academy in Keene. The set funds are divided into "units." Each unit represents a set dollar amount. Through this system we can establish an accurate number of units available and divide that into the total funds available to determine how much assistance each eligible family will receive. The application deadline is May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Only when the application time frame has passed, and the parish has reviewed the applications will units be allotted to each family.

It is essential that you apply within the provided time frame. We ask also that you apply for the various state programs available such as the Education Freedom Accounts (EFAs) and the Education Tax Credit Scholarships if you are eligible for those. Both programs are managed by the NH Children's Scholarship Fund (nh.scharlshipfund.org). Information is available at St. Joseph's and Our Lady of Mercy Academy. Taking advantage of the state assistance available will help the Parish of the Holy Spirit assist as many families as possible.
