PARISH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT 2022-23 SACRAMENT PREP/FAITH FORMATION

Fr. Alan spoke briefly at the SJRS Back-to-School Night about the plans for sacrament preparation this year and going forward. He explained the Bishop's thoughts and plans, and how they are being implemented beginning this year. In the past, sacrament preparation for SJRS/OLMA students has taken place through our Religion classes during the school day. The Bishop feels that the sacraments are based out of the church and that they are gifts of the church. Therefore, he wants all sacrament preparation to be based out of the churches/parishes. For those members of the Parish of the Holy Spirit, below is information about the plan for the coming year. Anyone who is part of our school community and is a member of another local Parish must speak with their own Parish about sacrament prep within their Parish. Religion classes at SJRS/OLMA will continue normally, and there will be discussion of the sacraments. But the specific sacrament prep discussions will be managed through the Parish.

The Parish of the Holy Spirit's Faith Formation Program this year will be based on the second volume of the Family of Faith series, which explores the beauty and meaning of the Sacraments. Come learn and experience how the Sacraments of the Church are gifts for living in fullness of life.

Our monthly parent meetings and family gatherings will explore this content and augment it with other material for supporting our relationship with Chris and one another. Families with children of all ages are welcome and encouraged to participate.

The program will include sacrament preparation for those who are eligible to receive First Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Communion. This will be the only preparation program available to children whose home parish is the Parish of the Holy Spirit.


Hello Mercy Families!
